NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. J/105s Fleet 8 rules, J/80 Fleet 4 rules, and J/120 Fleet 4 rules will be in effect. J/70 Rules, Part III-Section I, I.3 shall apply. Pac 52 Class rules will be in effect.
- 1.3. Marine Industry Representatives will be governed by the class rules for the class in which they are sailing. For ORR, ORR-ez and PHRF classes, any rules governing the participation of Marine Industry Representatives are waived.
- 1.4. US Sailing Prescriptions to 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.5. If there is a conflict between the NOR and the Sailing Instructions (SIs), SIs shall prevail.
- 1.6. San Diego Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Advertising is *un-restricted* subject to ISAF Regulation 20.2 and 20.3.
- 2.2. Boats may be required to display bow stickers for the duration of the event (ISAF Reg 20.4).

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to sailboats with a LOA of 20 feet or greater.
- 3.2. Eligible boats shall be either a one design fleet or a handicap class.
- 3.3. Eligible boats competing in a handicap class shall possess a current membership and valid rating certificate (provide on request - digital or web link) from the appropriate rating authority.
 - 3.3.1. PHRF San Diego or PHRF SoCal is required for all PHRF competitors.
 - 3.3.2. Either ORR (offshore@ussailing.org) / ORR-EZ (ora.rating.services@gmail.com) is required for all ORR / ORR-ez competitors.

- 3.4. In the event two or more yachts with identical one-design PHRF certificates are rated differently by their respective PHRF rating authorities, then the local San Diego PHRF one-design rating shall be applied to each.

4. ENTRY

- 4.1. Eligible boats may enter online at www.yachtingcup.com.
- 4.2. Entries close Tuesday, April 30, 2019 @ 1700.
- 4.3. If you have any questions or problems accessing an online entry, please contact our Sailing Office and we will be glad to assist you.

5. ENTRY FEES

- 5.1. To determine fees, a boat's LOA should be rounded to the lower whole number (i.e. 35' 8" = 35'):

Entry Type / Boats sized:	Prior to Apr 22	April 22 - 30
Non Spinnaker	\$75	\$125
≤ 21'	\$75	\$125
22' - 29'	\$150	\$250
30' - 49'	\$250	\$350
≥50	\$350	\$450

6. CLASSES

- 6.1.** Competitors will be divided into the following categories:
- 6.1.1.** One Design
 - 6.1.2.** Handicap Divisions:
PHRF, ORR, ORR-ez
 - 6.1.3.** Club Handicap Division:
Non Spinnaker
- 6.2.** Official Handicap Division breaks will be determined by the Organizing Authority. Provisional breaks may be posted prior to the event.
- 6.3.** One design classes or established handicap classes with five (5) or more paid entries prior to the close of entries (April 30, 2019) will receive their own start and compete as their own class/division.
- 6.4.** Any group of three or more boats, desiring to be scored as a subclass, may submit a written petition to the organizing authority for acceptance as a class or subclass prior to 1700, Monday, April 1, 2019.
- 6.5.** At the discretion of the OA, classes with three (3) or four (4) competitors may be assigned a start/compete within the most appropriate handicap division, and be scored both in that division and separately as a subclass, or may be given their own start or combined with another one design class and compete as their own class/division if space permits.
- 6.6.** Any Classes/Handicap Divisions wishing to compete for the Yachting Cup an additional day (Friday) shall notify the Yachting Cup OA of their intent prior to April 1, 2019.
- 6.7.** The Ton Cup will be held on Friday, May 3, 2019 as a separate event for all boats wishing to participate. Entry for Ton Cup is included in the Yachting Cup entry fee. Scores in the Ton Cup do NOT count towards Yachting Cup. Refer to Ton Cup Notice of Race for details.

7. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Friday, May 3

- 0900: Yachting Cup Check-In for 3-day Classes
- 0930: Yachting Cup Briefing for 3-day Classes
- 1130: Yachting Cup Warning for 3-day Classes
- 1200-1730: Yachting Cup Check-In 2-Day Classes
- 1730: Yachting Cup Party, Ton Cup Awards

Saturday, May 4

- 0830 – 0930: Yachting Cup Check-in
- 0930: Skippers Briefing
- 1130: Warning signal for all venues
- 1800: Yachting Cup Regatta Party

Sunday, May 5

- 1130: Warning signal for all venues
- After Racing: Awards ceremony as soon as possible after racing.

8. COURSES

- 8.1.** W/L races are scheduled for One Design, PHRF, ORR, and ORR-ez Yachting Cup classes.
- 8.2.** Non-spinnaker classes will sail Random Leg courses.

9. MEASUREMENT

- 9.1.** Each boat competing in a handicap class shall possess a valid rating certificate from the appropriate rating authority.
- 9.2.** Any class desiring to weigh in crew or otherwise measure equipment, shall do so by their own authority.
- 9.3.** Boats in the non-spinnaker class will be assigned a rating by the SDYC Handicapper.

10. SAILING AREA AND SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 10.1.** The Yachting Cup sailing areas will be in the Coronado Roads and South Bay. Alternate venues may be used depending on weather and classes.

10.2. Official Sailing Instructions, Course Assignments and Starting Order will be available at Check Ins detailed in NOR 7, and on the event website as soon as available.

11. SCORING

11.1. Handicap scoring for PHRF and Non Spinnaker
Corrected time = Time on Distance.

11.2. Handicap scoring for ORR and ORR-ez
Corrected time = elapsed time x TCF.

11.3. Up to ten races are scheduled for 3-Day Classes.

11.4. Up to seven races are scheduled for 2-Day Classes.

11.5. One race each day are scheduled for the Non-Spinnaker classes.

11.6. Unless otherwise directed by class rules, four completed races will constitute a series; a boat's worst race score will be excluded when six or more races are completed.

12. AWARDS

12.1. Awards for each class are dependent on number of entries.

12.2. Awards will be presented at San Diego Yacht Club as soon as possible at the conclusion of Sunday racing.



The Yachting Cup is registered with Sailors for the Sea as a Clean Regatta. As such, all competitors' attention is drawn to the second Basic Principle of the Racing Rules of Sailing - Environmental Responsibility, which states: "Participants are encouraged to minimize any adverse environmental impact of the sport of sailing."

▶ TON CUP:

- Entry is free for all Yachting Cup entrants.
- Entry is \$35 for Ton Cup only entrants.
- Competitors meeting: Friday, May 3 @ 1400
- Warning for first fleet: Friday, May 3 @ 1530
- See Ton Cup Notice of Race (www.yachtingcup.com).
- Ton Cup Entry Form is the same as Yachting Cup.

▶ SOCIAL

- Friday Night: Beginning at 1730, a welcome party will be hosted with food and drink at San Diego Yacht Club for all competitors of Yachting Cup and Ton Cup. Guests and SDYC members may purchase tickets.
- Saturday Night: After racing, the bar, deck and restaurant area of SDYC will host a party for all competitors. Guests and SDYC members may purchase tickets.

▶ BERTHING, STORAGE and PARKING

- San Diego Yacht Club is pleased to offer free mooring at our docks to all registered Yachting Cup competitors whose yacht's home port is outside of San Diego.
- Free mooring will begin on Wednesday, May 1 and go through Wednesday, May 8. Boats must register with Dockmaster Ty Olsen via email at dockmaster@sdyc.org prior to April 15 to ensure dock space.
- Each registered yacht that is not of SDYC registry will receive a parking pass that will entitle one vehicle to park in the SDYC lot from May 1 - May 8.
- Teams wanting to park equipment trailers at SDYC need to contact Dockmaster Ty Olsen prior to arrival for permission. SDYC will attempt to provide parking lot space for trailers as space is available.
