NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. San Diego Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.
- 1.2. The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.3. Boats shall be sailed by three- or four-person teams. There is no weight limit.
- 1.4. The regatta will be sailed in J/22-type boats provided by SDYC and will not utilize spinnakers. J/22 class rules will not apply.
- 1.5. The regatta will consist of short-course fleet racing including an Opening series and Final series. Teams will rotate boats. The format details will be posted in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.6. All competitors in this regatta **shall wear a PFD**, while on the water, other than for brief periods while adding or removing clothing. (This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to RRS Part 4).
- 1.7. Appendix T2 (Arbitration) will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Any entry in the Yachting Cup may enter one team for the Ton Cup.
- 2.2. Teams sign up for the Ton Cup at the time of signing up for the subsequent Yachting Cup, at www.yachtingcup.com.
- 2.3. Entries for Ton Cup **close on Sunday, April 26, 2026 @ 1700**. All entry forms and fees must be submitted to the Sailing Office.
- 2.3. The event is limited to 24 teams.
- 2.4. In the event a space becomes available, waitlisted teams will be notified of their acceptance as soon as possible, and no later than Thursday, April 30, 2026.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Ton Cup entry is free and only for boats entered in the Yachting Cup.
- 3.2. All teams must designate a credit card or SDYC charge account to be used in the event boat damage is attributed to a team's use of the boats. Accounts may be charged up to \$1,000 per incident if assigned responsibility.

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1. Boats will be made available for practice on Thursday, April 30, 2026 from 1200 to 1600. Practice must be arranged by adding your name to the [TC Practice Sign-up Sheet](#).
- 4.2. Check-in for Ton Cup teams will be Friday May 1, 2026, from 1200 -1230 at the end of E dock.
- 4.3. Competitors' Meeting will be held Friday May 1, 2026, at 1230 at the end of E dock.
- 4.4. The warning signal for the first race is scheduled for 1300. No warning signal will be made after 1600.
- 4.5. Post-race social event and Yachting Cup Welcome Party will be held immediately following racing. All participants and their guests are welcome to attend.

5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available online by 1700 Thursday, April 30, 2026.

6. VENUE AND COURSE

6.1. The racing area for the Ton Cup will be in La Playa Cove, adjacent to the San Diego Yacht Club.
6.2. Course configuration and length will vary by format set forth in sailing instructions.

7. SCORING

7.1. Scoring system will be in accordance with RRS Appendix A, or as modified by the sailing instructions.

8. AWARDS

8.1. Ton Cup awards will be presented Sunday, May 3, 2026, along with Yachting Cup awards.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 3, decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Application form includes an agreement to these terms.
